Group B is eligible to receive the CMU Presidential Scholarship for the 2022 Academic Year (Round 3) with the condition that they are eligible to receive the scholarship from the first semester of the 2022 academic year. To be eligible to receive their scholarship in the second semester of the 2022 academic year the candidates' GPA in the first semester of the 2022 academic year must not be less than 3.50.

For applicants in the thesis/dissertation only program, the thesis proposal topic must be approved within 1 academic year for a Master's degree or 3 regular semesters for Ph.D. in order to continue receiving their scholarship the next semester.

Nominated scholarship candidates must contact their appropriate faculty in order to confirm their scholarship by <u>22 August 2022</u> and be eligible to receive their scholarship in the first semester of the 2022 academic year.
